REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS (B.F.A) EXAMINATION

1. Examination for the degree of bachelor of fine arts shall be held in part viz. I, II, III, IV year and shall be open to a candidate.
Who had undergone a regular course of study and attended a required percentage of lectures and tutorials and has undergone the required practical training in teaching and in practical work for a period specified for the examinations (hereinafter to be called regular student), or
2. Who has failed : o pass either parts of the examination or who was unable to appear at either parts of the examination after having undergone a regular course of study vide Para' above, (hereinafter to be called ex- student), provide that.
3. The regular student has passed the senior secondary examination and during the course of regular study the candidate does not pursue, any other study or vocation and that.
4. The ex- student in theory papers only on the recommendation of the dean of faculty of education has been registered as an ex- student after a payment of prescribed registration fee for ex- student for each academic sessions, provided the (the application for such registration may be entertained and the registration fee may be accepted in a special case at the discretion of the controller examination after expiry of the prescribed date up to 31st december on payment of prescribed penalty fee, provided also that.
5. The Candidate has attended at least 75% of lectures in each subject, 75% of tutorials and 75% periods in each craft and in practical work.
6. An ex- student shall not be kept on the rolls for more than two consecutive year after the candidate appears for the examination as a regular student in either parts of bachelor of fine arts examination

7. The regular student ex- student at the time of enrollment signs a declaration that on admission the candidate submits him/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of
8. The examination of fine arts shall comprise of theory consisting of :
 - a) Written examination papers and
 - b) Sessional work
 - c) Practical (academic council) on the recommendation of faculty of Education.
9. The written paper will be examined externally and the sessional work connected with each paper will be examined internally. Practical work, practice teaching and craft work will be evaluated internally in I, II and III year the written papers as well as practical will be examined externally in IV year. The sessional work relate to those papers will be evaluated internally.
10. The internal evaluation of sessional work in theory and the subsidiary crafts, practical work and practice teaching will be completed by moderation committees comprising of the head of the department of fine arts & art education as chairman, the staff member (s) concerned and the knowledgeable member (s) of the faculty of education to be nominated by the dean of the faculty of education, provide that.
11. A moderation board consisting of 5 members, namely the dean, faculty of education or his nominee, the head of the department of fine arts and art education as chairman, one member of the teaching staff and two external experts by the by the concerned Board of Studies/Committee of Studies.

Duration of Course : The total duration of course will be of Four Academic Years
Attendance : As Per University Rules

For teaching and examination in the practical courses the class should be divided in batches. There should not be more than 30 students in a batch.

Theory Paper should be allotted another individual period.

A candidate must pass in theory and practical paper separately.

A candidate must be submit sessional work before the practical examination otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear in the practical examination.
